
MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. The Florida National Guard (FLNG) Counterdrug (CD) Program is seeking a qualified officer to serve as a Pilot for the FLNG Counterdrug RC-26 located at 125th Fighter Wing, Jacksonville, Florida. Selectee will be required to maintain aircraft proficiency in addition to other assigned duties. Additional requirements are outlined on reverse.
2. Selection of an out-of-state guardsman/active duty member is contingent upon availability of compatible FLNG unit vacancy and may require an interview by the COS/ESSO for appointment in the Florida National Guard. Selectee must have approval of their unit commander and be qualified for the unit position they will occupy. IAW NGR 500-2, selectee will remain in assigned FLNG unit and will be required to attend all UTAs and ATs. Selectee will also be required to maintain aircrew training manual requirements in unit assigned aircraft, if applicable.
3. Selectee will present a favorable military image and be required to uphold the highest standards of conduct and military personal appearance while on Counterdrug tour.
4. Selected individual will be placed on Title 32 FTNGD-CD orders beginning tentatively June 2008. PCS may be authorized. Contingent upon budget approval and duty performance, orders may be renewed for future fiscal year. Participation in the FLNG CD Program is contingent upon receipt/availability of congressional appropriations each fiscal year and mission requirements/priority. Orders may be curtailed if funds are not appropriated.
5. The Florida National Guard is an Equal Opportunity Employer and all qualified applicants will receive consideration for this announcement without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, or gender.

1. Letter of introduction (include position number) stating your interest in the position and how you will add value to the program.
2. Resume outlining civilian/military experience and education.
3. Copy of current Records Review RIP.
4. Submit copies of Flight Evaluation Folder (FEF).
5. Submit current, certified AF Form 422 (conducted within past 2 years) for review by State Air Surgeon and results of HIV test taken within past 5 months. If current periodic physical is over 2 years old, schedule an induction physical.
6. AF Form 895 completed within past 30 days.
7. Copy of AFPFT certificates reflecting last two physical fitness tests scores.
8. AF Form 526 (Retirement Points) and DD Forms 214.
9. Original DD Form 369 certified within past 30 days.
10. Commander's letter of recommendation.
11. Copies of last 5 performance reports.
12. Copy of valid drivers' license.

**FLNG COUNTERDRUG POSITION #08-24
C-26 Pilot (ADSW)**

Minimum Job Skill Requirements:

- Fixed wing rated pilot meeting all related criteria
- Computer Literate (NT4.0, Windows, Spread Sheets, Word Processors, Databases, etc.)
- Multi-media communications and presentations
- Public speaking/media relations
- Typing ability (20 wpm)

Minimum Administrative Requirements:

- United States citizen proficient in the English Language (Read, Write, and Speak)
- Member/Eligible to become member of the Florida National Guard (Adhering to basic FLNG Standards)
- Have negative results on Drug Urinalysis.
- Not have any suspension of favorable action pending.
- Have a favorable National Agency Check (NAC/ENTNAC) within past 10 years.
- Must meet the Active Duty initial induction medical standards as outlined in AFI 48-123, Attachment 3. Current physical must be within past 24 months and AF Form 895 must be completed within past 30 days. If current physical is over 24 months old, report to nearest MEPS or active component military medical treatment facility authorized to conduct an active duty induction physical examination. Cite NGR 500-2, para 8-16a, and TAG Command Policy Memorandum as authority. HIV test must be within 6 months prior to orders start date. If over 40 years of age, submit Cardiac Risk Index.
- Meet height and weight standards. Failure to maintain weight control standards after selection will result in immediate termination of Counterdrug duty.
- Meet physical fitness standards. Failure to maintain physical fitness standards after selection will result in immediate termination of Counterdrug duty.
- Pass a background check. Failure to meet acceptable standards after selection will result in immediate termination of Counterdrug duty.
- Possess a Secret and qualify for a Top Secret security clearance.
- Possess valid Florida driver's license (or be eligible for same).

Preferred Additional Skills:

- Knowledge of scheduling duties and functions
- Ability to evaluate and determine training requirements
- Skills in written / oral communication and interpersonal relations
